

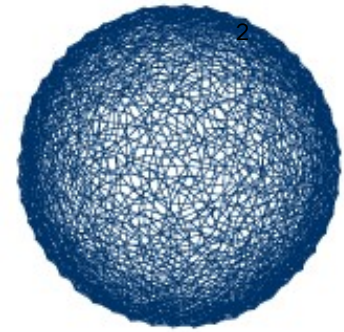

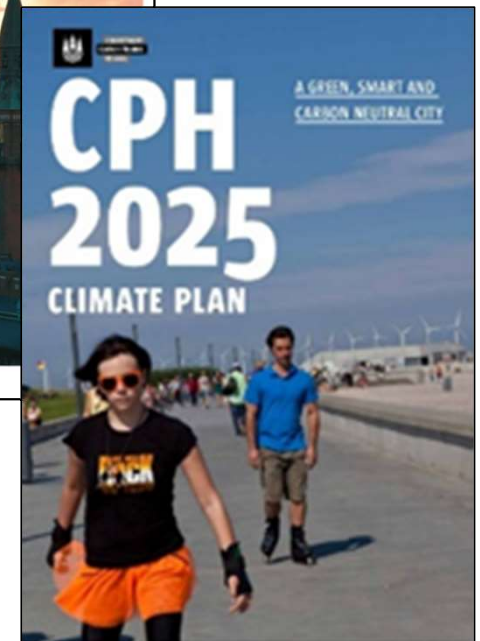
# Adoption of the carbon neutrality target



- The City of Copenhagen adopted a Climate Action Plan in 2009 with a target of reducing CO<sub>2</sub>-emissions with 20% in 2015 and a vision of becoming carbon neutral by 2025.
- The CPH2025 Climate Plan was adopted in 2012 with the target of a carbon neutral capital in 2025.

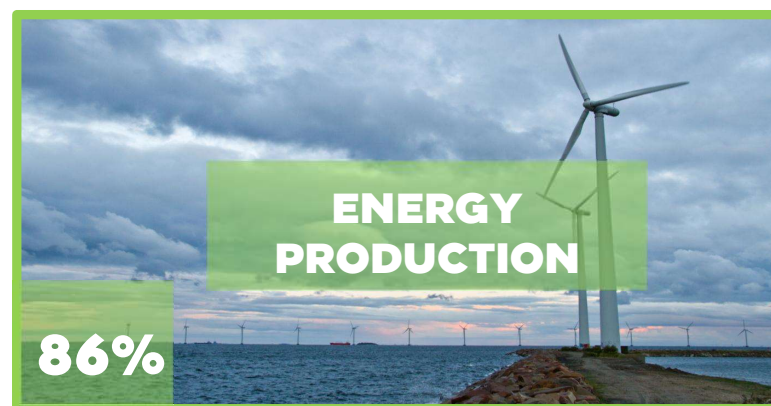

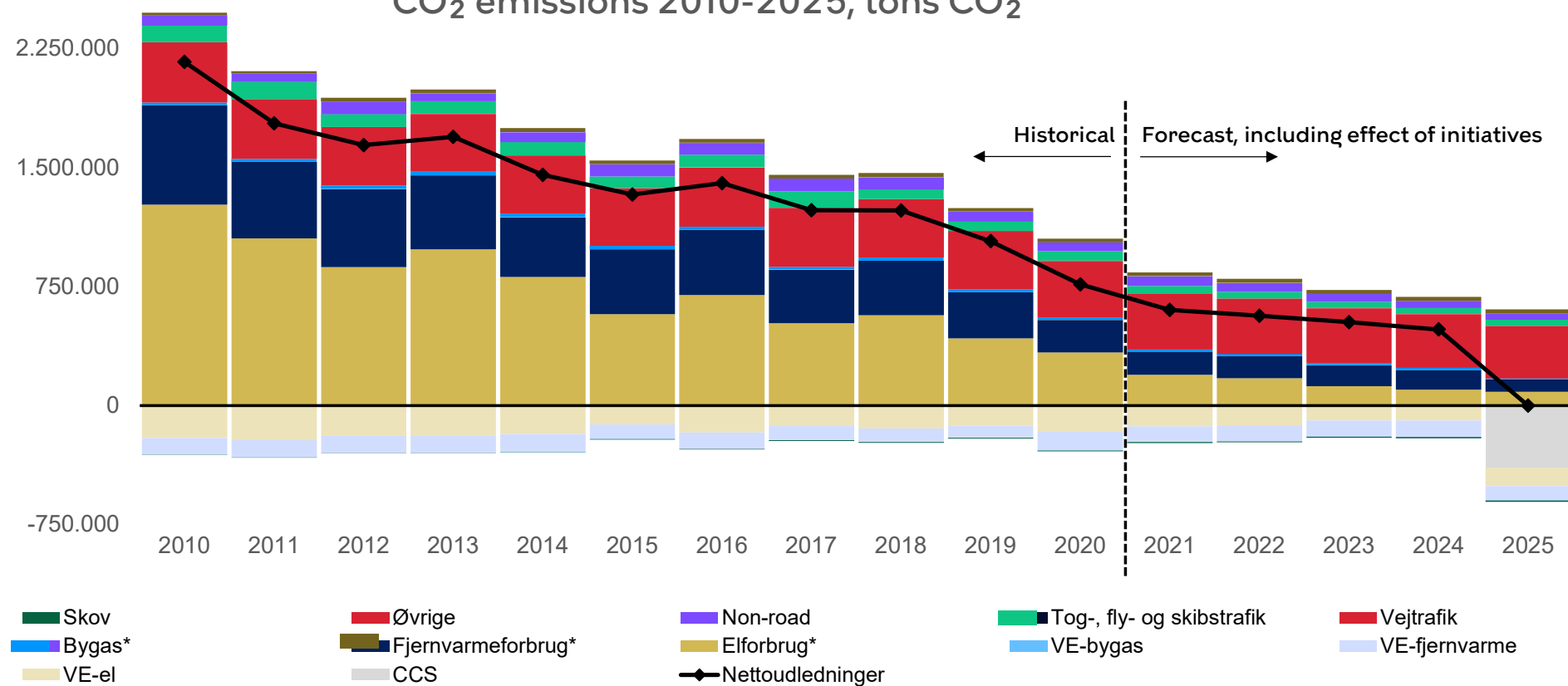

CO<sub>2</sub> emissions 2010-2025, tons CO<sub>2</sub>



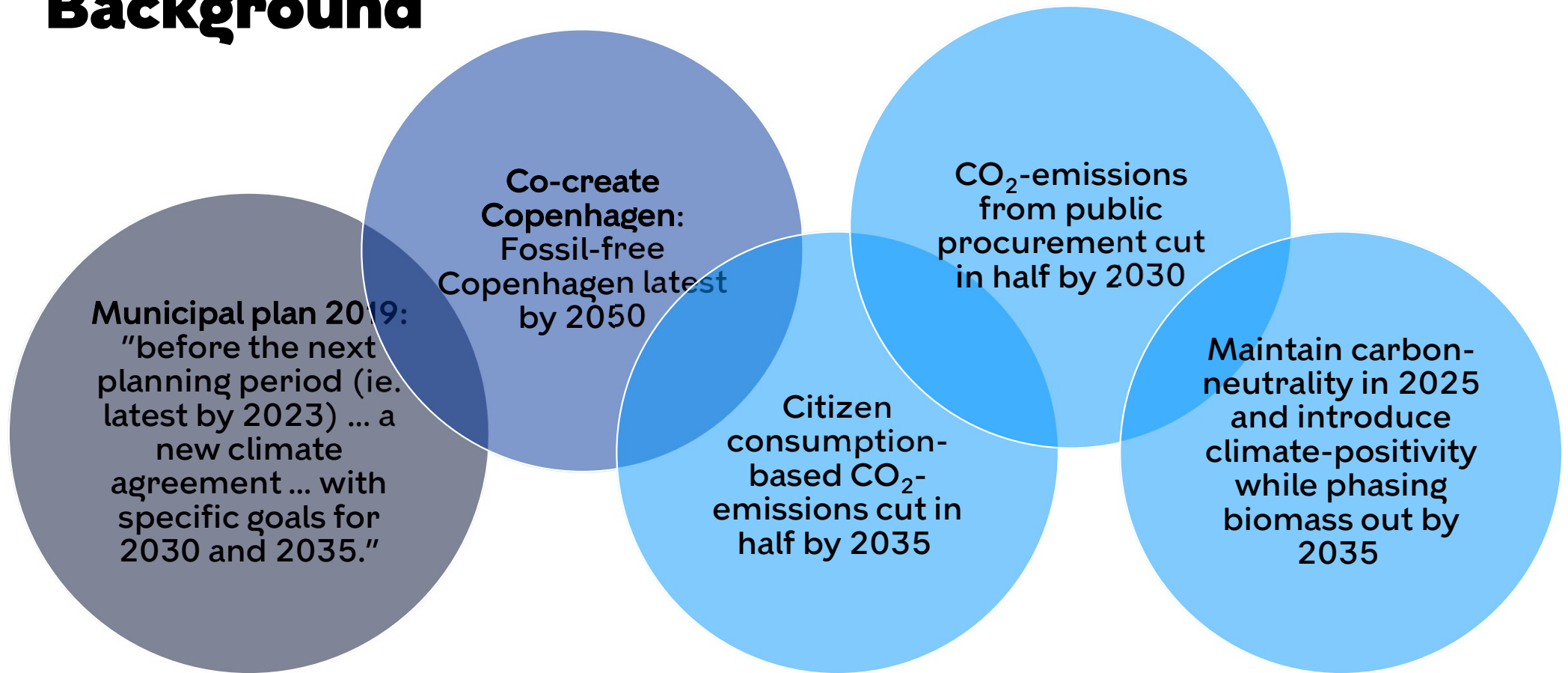
\*Before RE-crediting, which involves renewable energy production within the city or outside the city where the city or the city's utilities own the facilities.

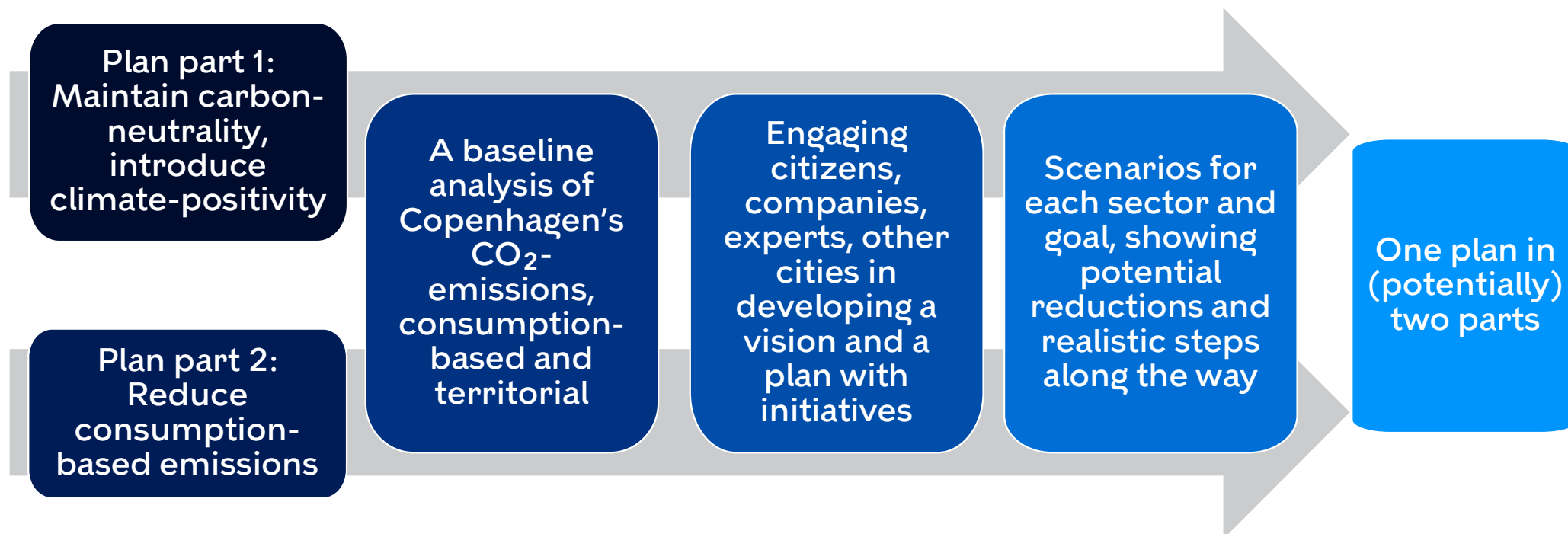

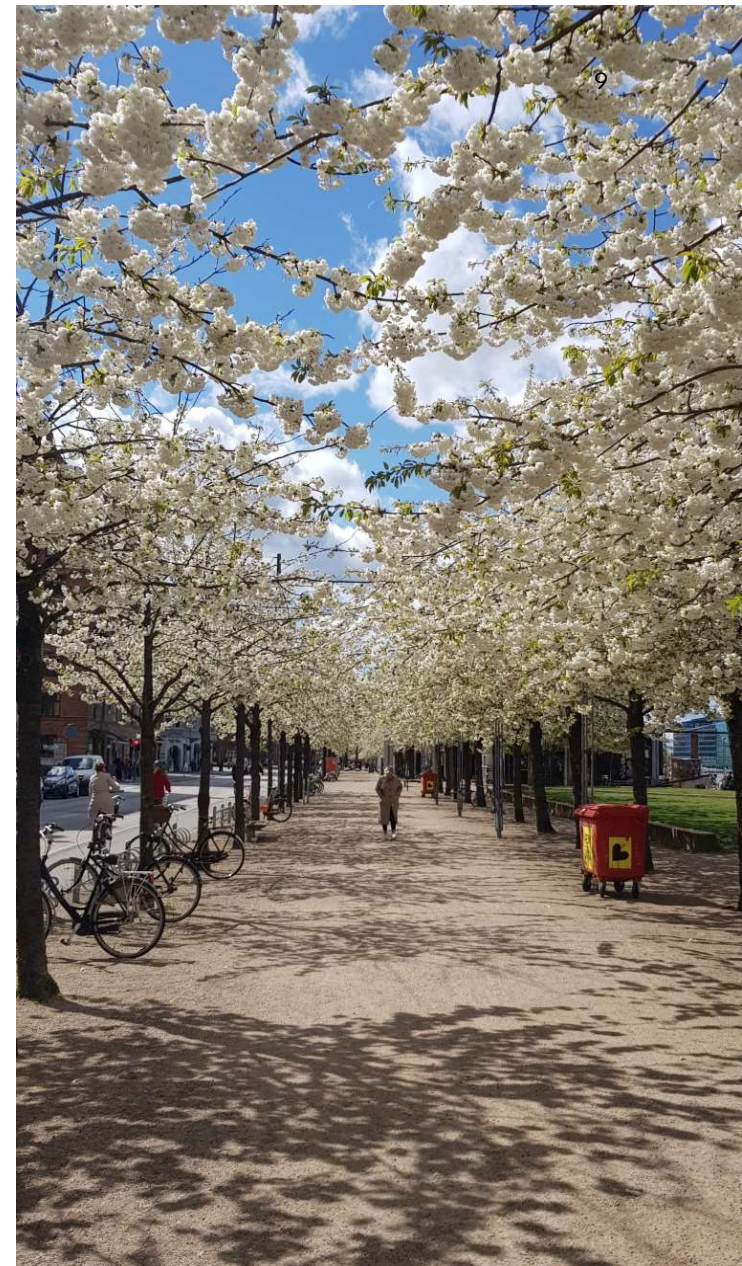
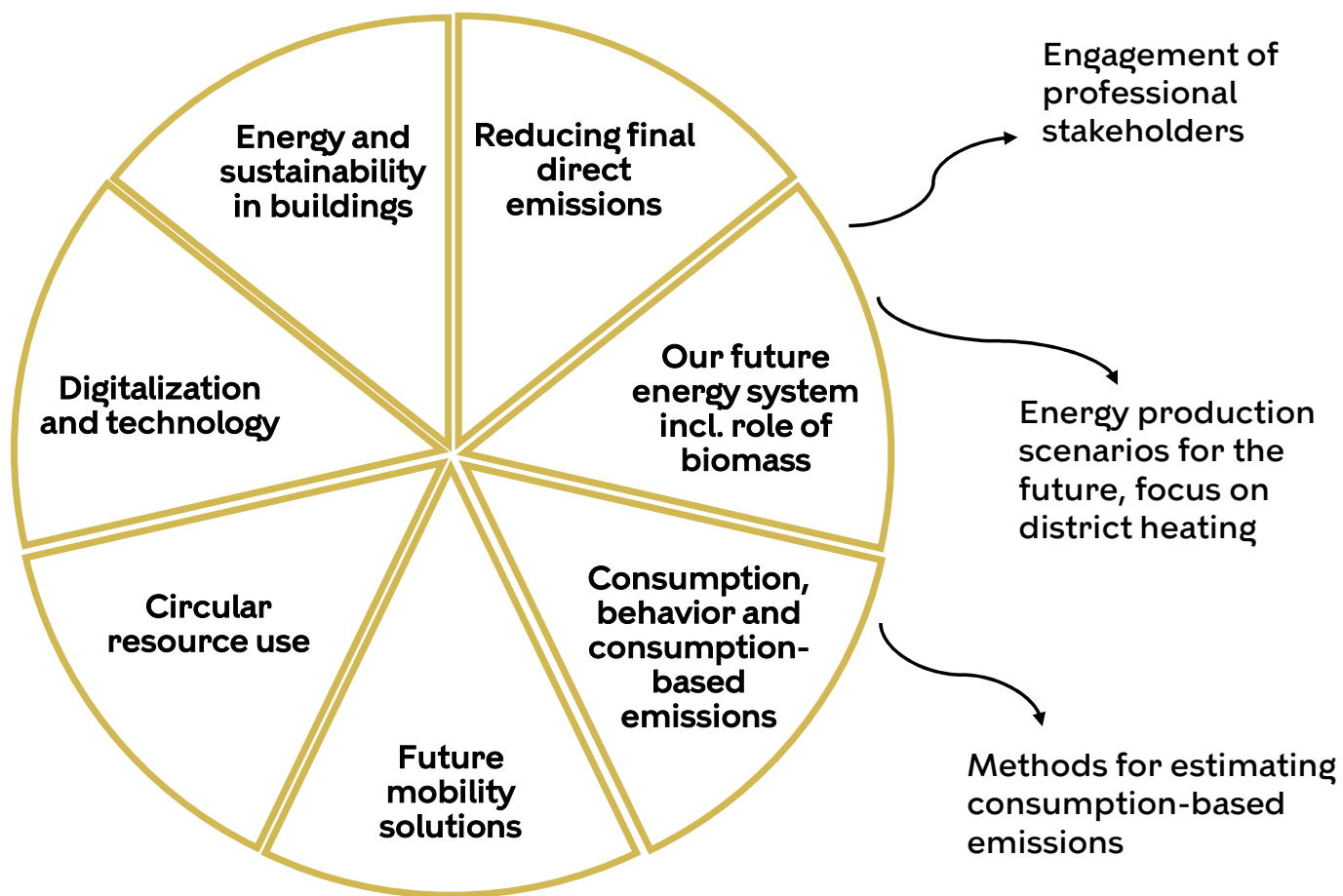
